Ammonia

Any liquids that might spill

Car Batteries

Charcoal

Chemistry Sets

Cleaning Solvents

Fertilizer

Fire Extinguisher

Fireworks

Gasoline

Household Batteries

Kerosene

Lamp Oils

Lighters

Liquid Bleach

Matches

Motor Oil

Nail Polish

Nail Polish Remover

Paint Thinner

Paints (latex & oil-based)

Pesticides

Poisons (such as weed killer)

Pool Chemicals

Propane/Propane Tanks
